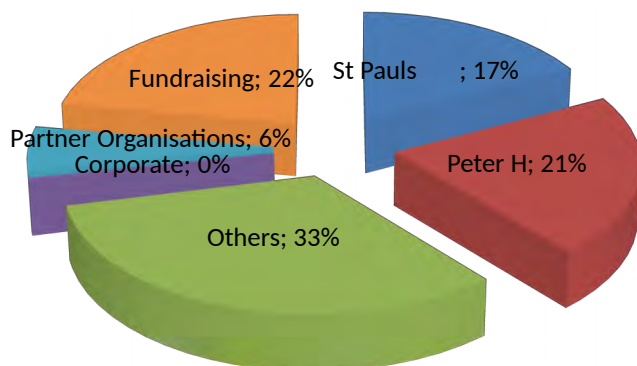

☐ After shakes

A brief update of the emergency relief work over the last two months – these projects are a joint effort between IGWR and SUNSAR MAYA as working together we achieve even more:

- Reopened the after-school program to provide our kids with a safe place to be while schools were closed, and the comfort of a caring environment to help process the disaster
- Provided almost 2000 families with emergency food packages in the immediate days after the earthquake
- Provided tin roof kits and soft flooring to 250 homeless families for temporary structures and protection from the wet during monsoon season
- Operated two free medical clinics (with more planned) where hundreds of people received free services and prescription medicine
- Building temporary housing in the villages of Banepa and Nuwakot for families that have lost their homes
- Building new classrooms and toilets at village schools that were destroyed in the earthquakes

We have been *trying* to help the children at “Aruna’s Orphanage” for quite some time and together with SUNSAR MAYA have certainly given the children access to full time education and to the “After School Program” that we operate together.

We are now working with the children’s welfare agency and anticipate that Aruna’s will be closed down very soon.

We have offered to take over the responsibility for the ongoing care of the 14 children involved; and we are currently seeking to establish budgets and determine a plan that will enable us (with SUNSAR MAYA) to give these delightful children the chance they (and all children) deserve in life.

The rescue will involve a substantial commitment; and knowing the generosity of all who have been involved with IGWR we can with confidence take this on, trusting that what we need will come. 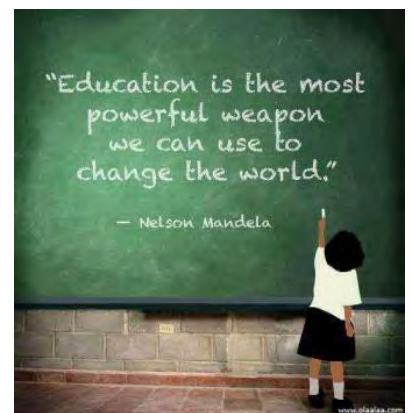


Do you want to buy a car?
